

What is going on in:
Reading? We will be starting our novel, The BFG this week. I encourage each student to try to obtain a copy of the story so that you may take notes in your own book. We will be paying attention to the vocabulary, the sequence, the literary elements, and drawing conclusions about the characters, and their motivations as we move through the story.

ALERT! Our first book report will be assigned this week! Students will receive a book report assignment every $4-5$ weeks. The kids will read a book (it must be approved by me first), and then will complete a project after. Each report will be different and will be challenging the kids to reach different goals. The first report will be assigned Monday, the $12^{\mathrm{th}}$ of September, and due October $20^{\mathrm{th}}$.

Math? We are working on Unit one this week. Our topics will include finding differences, calculator routines, and solving problems using money.
NOTE: Remember, your child needs a durable container with 30 pennies, and 10 each of every other coin (quarter, dime, and nickel)


Science? Our first unit will be the scientific method, science safety rules, science tools, and terms. This week we will be concentrating on the steps of the scientific method. How do we face a question like a scientist? What steps do we take in order to back up our hunches and ideas?

Social Studies? Our first unit in social studies is Maps and Geography. This week we will be learning about reading and interpreting maps. We will be using the map title, map key, directions, and symbols to help us.
