Committee Reports

Curriculum Committee – Mrs. Rounds

- Mrs. Rounds discussed some of the findings in the 2013 45th annual PDK Gallup Poll
- Ms. Anderson extended hats off to students/staff/parents/administrators for the

 As, 1B and 1 C. She also recognized our strong ACT and SAT results.
- Ms. Anderson updated the Board on 9-12 Fitness and the new electives offered.

- Ms. Anderson also discussed the Third Grade Reading Guarantee; PD that is being offered to staff this year; organizing a review of our Strategic Plan; and announced that we have three National Merit Finalist from RRHS: Emma McGorray, Tuy Montgomery and Will Spallino.
