HOME EDUCATION NOTIFICATION / APPLICATION FORM 3301-34-02 STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of the rules in this chapter is to prescribe conditions governing the issuance of excuses from school attendance under section 3321.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, to provide for the consistent application thereof throughout the state by superintendents, and to safeguard the primary right of parents to provide the education for their child(ren). Home education must be in accordance with the law.

		Assurance that home education will include the following, except that home education shall not be required to include any concept, topic, or practice that is in conflict with sincerely held religious beliefs of the parent: (a) Language, reading, spelling and writing: (b) Geography, History of the United States, and Ohio, and National, State and Local Government; (c) Mathematics; (d) Science; (e) Health; (f) Physical education; (g) Fine arts, including music; and (h) First aid, safety and fire prevention.

3301-34-04 Academic Assessment

- A. The parent(s) shall send to the superintendent an academic assessment report of the child for the **previous school** year at the time of supplying subsequent notification.
- **B.** The academic assessment report shall include one of the following:
 - 1. Results of a nationally normed, standardized achievement test. This test shall be administered by:
 - a the Rocky River City Schools during the annual administration cycle at no charge to the parents, or
 - b. a certified teacher, or
 - c. another person mutually agreed upon by the parent(s) and the Executive Director of Pupil Services, or
 - d. a person duly authorized by the publisher of the test.
 - e. Results should demonstrate reasonable proficiency as compared to other children in the district at the same grade level. Any child who has a composite score at or above the twenty-fifth percentile shall be deemed to be performing at a level of reasonable proficiency.
 - 2. A written narrative prepared by a certified teacher or a person mutually agreed upon by the parents(s) and the Executive Director of Pupil Services, indicating that a portfolio of the child's work has been reviewed by that person and that the child's academic progress for the year is in accordance with the child's abilities.
 - **3.** Parent(s) shall be responsible for the payment of fees charged for preparation of this narrative.
 - **4.** An alternative academic assessment of the child's proficiency mutually agreed upon by the parent(s) and Executive Director of Pupil Services.
 - 5. If the parent(s) chooses to have the standardized testing conducted as part of the school district scheduled testing program, it shall be at no cost to the parent(s). The time and location for testing shall be established by the school district.
 - **6.** If the parent(s) chooses to have the standardized testing conducted privately, the parent(s) shall pay for the testing time and location for testing shall be established by the parent(s).
