Capital Forecast

Mr. Manoloff continued the discussion of the capital forecast/list of needs that has taken place over the last several months. As the Administration has worked to schedule out various capital needs over the next four – five years, this has given us a clearer picture of the annual amounts needed. Mr. Manoloff requested that Mr. Markus begin to look at financing options through an HB 262 financing and any other means that may allow the District to finance some of the capital needs over several years. Mr. Markus will work with Mr. Sywanyk, Mr. Gifford and Dr. Shoaf to begin this evaluation process with firms that may offer these services. He will then report back to the finance committee in February and we can then determine if we should move forward with a form RFQ process as required by Ohio Administrative Code.

All Day Kindergarten

Mr. Manoloff also moved the discussion to all-day kindergarten to wrap up any final issues or questions on the process before the Board considered the tuition that would be charged for this additional service. Board members in attendance provided their opinion and there appeared to be general agreement that tuition should be set at the high end of the proposed range of \$3,400 in order to cover as much of the projected additional costs as possible. This topic will be brought up at this evening's regular board meeting for final debate and a decision.

Financial Summary - December 2015

Mr. Markus shared the following information with the committee and others in attendance related to the monthly and fiscal YTD financials of the district:

December was another light month revenue-wise as the property tax settlement and homestead and rollback payments had already been received in prior months. There were minimal variances from estimates in all other revenue lines for the month. We will be receiving the first tax advance of the second half of the fiscal year in January as well as a semi-annual casino tax payment. The majority of our property tax revenue for this cycle will be received in February.

On the expenditure side, salaries came in over the estimate due to timing of supplemental contracts as there were a few supplemental contracts that were submitted late. However, benefits were moderately under budget for the month and should continue to trend that way. The contracted services line came in significantly lower than anticipated due to a timing difference with the Lakewood Career Tech tuition payment being paid during November instead of December. This area is now trending below estimates for the fiscal YTD. Supplies/materials, capital outlay and other objects came in below estimates for the month based on the earlier trend of purchasing in these areas tailing off as expected and are now trending below estimates for the fiscal YTD as well.

Please reference the SM-2 Comparison Report for how our FY 16 revenue and expenditure data compared to FY 15 amounts. Total fiscal YTD revenues (excluding other financing sources) ended below the fiscal 2015 amount by -0.44% while total fiscal YTD expenditures (excluding other financing uses) ended above the fiscal 2014 amount by 4.96%.

The main reason revenue is down slightly overall is mainly due to a timing difference in line 1.040 due to the catastrophic cost reimbursement payment between years offset in large part by the expected increase in property tax revenue as well as a small increase in state basic aid. Additionally, the All Other Financial Sources line (line 2.060) in the Other Financing Sources section is down significantly due to the directing of federal QSCB interest subsidy payment to the Bond Retirement Fund instead of the General Fund.

Salary expenditures show a significant year over year increase due to contractual increases for all employees and the 11.41 additional FTE's now reflected on our payroll. Supplies/materials are up significantly due to the payment for new textbooks and other materials that were carried over as encumbrances from June 30. However, mitigating the overall expenditure increase somewhat is the fact that purchased services are down year over year—due to decreases in lease/purchase payments and instructional subs through the County ESC despite some—increases in maintenance/repair and other areas within this category. Also, capital outlay expenditures are down—year over year due to an overall reduction in capital spending from the General Fund.

The previously abated values from Westgate that came back onto the tax duplicate were not certified in time, so they were not actually reflected on the Schedule A from the State. However, I added them above to the commercial values as they are in fact taxable values as this was confirmed with the County.

The effective rates above show an increase or decrease based on the calculation under HB 920. Given that the majority of the increase in residential property was due to the update of property values, HB 920 would reduce the effective millage accordingly so that there would not be a net tax increase based on the updated values. Conversely, there was a decrease in commercial values based on the property update in addition to a net decrease due to BOR/BTA decisions, so therefore the effective millage for the property classification was increased under HB 920. Public utility tangible tax rates are not effected by HB 920.
