Appointment of Independent Financial Advisor

BE IT RESOLVED by the Rocky River Board of Education that Sudsina & Associates, LLC, Michael G. a. Resolution to Approve Financial Statement and Intrafund Transfers for General Accounting – May 2010

WHEREAS, the Board of Education passed Resolution #8-10 to dispense with the Listing of Warrants; and

WHEREAS, the funds for payment of these vouchers are included in the 2009-2010 Appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has reviewed the Financial Statement, Appropriation Expenditure Summary Report, and the List of Bills;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that the Financial Statement and intrafund transfers in the amount of \$106,250.06 for May 2010 be included in the minutes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Financial Statements (**Exhibit A**) also be included in the Minutes and that the Appropriation Expenditure Summary Report and the List of Bills be filed in the Treasurer's Office for Audit.

b. Resolution to Amend Appropriation May 2010

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that the amount of the amended appropriation for all funds as of May 31, 2010 is \$39,079.744, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the current Certificate of Resources (**Exhibit B**) in effect identifies sufficient resources to operate the education program for Fiscal 2010 (July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010).

c. Resolution to Approve Then and Now Certificate

WHEREAS, the requirements of ORC Section 5705.41(D) state that no orders or contracts involving the expenditure of money are to be made unless there is a certificate of the fiscal officer that the amount required for the order or contract has been lawfully appropriated and is in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances; and

WHEREAS, ORC Section 5705.41(D) provides an exception that, if the fiscal officer can certify that both at the time that the contract or order was made and at the time that he is completing his certification, sufficient funds were available or in the process of collection to the credit of a proper fund, properly appropriated and free from any previous encumbrance, the taxing authority can authorize the drawing of a warrant. The taxing authority has 30 days from the receipt of such certificate to approve payment by resolution or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Then and Now Certificates submitted to the Rocky River Board of Education (**Exhibit C**) be approved and that the Treasurer is hereby authorized to draw a warrant for the orders or contracts associated with such certificates as soon as reasonably

d. Resolution to Amend Appropriation and Approve Transfers Between Funds-2010

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Board of Education during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sums as set forth at the fund level for the Appropriation Resolution be approved, such amounts by fund to be within the final Certificate of Estimated Resources submitted on or before June 30, 2010, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer is authorized to make appropriation changes, adjustments and transfers as might be necessary, such changes in the aggregate by fund not to exceed the available revenues and the final appropriation amount and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Board, the Treasurer, and the Superintendent are hereby directed to sign an amended Annual Appropriation Measure Certificate and that the Treasurer forward such signed Certificate to the County Auditor and a copy placed in the minutes.

e. Resolution to Approve Fund to Fund Transfers and Advances for 2009-2010

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District has been authorized to receive funds for the operation of the following funds but have not received sufficient actual funds to pay all obligations as of this date; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that the Treasurer is authorized and hereby directed to advance the amounts from the General Fund to be determined by the date of the Board meeting.

f. Resolution to Approve 2010-1011 Appropriation

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Board of Education during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sums as set forth in the Annual Appropriation Resolution be and the same are hereby set aside and appropriated for the several purposes for which expenditures are to be made for and during said fiscal year; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer is hereby directed to file a copy of said Appropriation with the County Auditor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Board, the Treasurer, and the Superintendent are hereby directed to sign an Annual Appropriation Measure Certificate and that the Treasurer forward such signed Certificated to the County Auditor and a copy placed in the minutes.

g. A Resolution Requesting the County Auditor to Advance to the District Moneys in the County Treasury to the Account of the District

WHEREAS, in accordance with Revised Code § 321.34, this Board may request that the County Auditor advance to the District both (i) money in the County treasury to the account of the District that is lawfully applicable to the purposes of the current fiscal year, and (ii) money in the County treasury to the account of the District that is to be included in the real and public utility property tax settlement under Revised Code § 321.24(C); and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of a resolution requesting an advance of money in the County treasury to the account of the District that is to be included in the real and public utility property tax settlement under Revised Code § 321.24(C), the County Auditor is to make an advance payment of such available money; and

WHEREAS, money in the County treasury to the account of the District that is to be included in the real and public utility property tax settlement under Revised Code § 321.24(C) becomes lawfully applicable to the purposes of the current fiscal year in which such a request is made if this Board specifies its intent to use the money for purposes of the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, due to current budgetary considerations, this Board has determined that it is necessary and appropriate (i) to request that the County Auditor advance to the District on or before June 30, 2010, any such money as shall be deemed needed and become available in the County treasury to the account of the District, and (ii) to use all such money (including, without limitation, money in the County treasury to the account of the District that is to be included in the real and public utility property tax settlement under Revised Code § 321.24(C)) for purposes of the current fiscal year. Further, it is the intent of the Board to only request monies that have been collected on its behalf prior to the second half 2009 (collection year 2010) real property bills being distributed, since these monies were attributable to calendar year 2009 and prior years collections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Board hereby requests the County Auditor to advance to the District on or before June 30, 2010, both (i) money in the County treasury to the account of the District that is lawfully applicable to the purposes of the current fiscal year, and (ii) money in the County treasury to the account of the District that is to be included in the real and public utility property tax settlement under Revised Code § 321.24(C), in accordance with Revised Code §§ 321.34(A) and (B).

Section 2. This Board determines and declares that it intends to use all of the money so advanced (including, particularly, money in the County treasury to the account of the District that is to be included in the real and public utility property tax settlement under Revised Code § 321.24(C)) for purposes of Fiscal Year 2010.

Section 3. The Treasurer of this Board is authorized and directed to immediately certify a copy of this resolution to the Cuyahoga County Auditor.

Section 4. This Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meeting open to the public, in compliance with law.

Section 5. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
