Mapping Out Our Week

Reading: Reading Workshop

In reading, we will continue reading to determine the author's point of view of a topic. We will also compare his/her point of view to our own. In anticipation of the upcoming holidays, we will be learning about Christmas Around the World through literature, arts, and culture.

Writing: Writing Workshop

In writing, we will continue to work on verbs and replacing "boring" words with exciting ones! We will be continuing to practice paragraph writing in order to identify/explain the author's point of view. We will also be using our ChromeBooks to revise previously-written work.

Math: Unit 5 - Measurement/Data

Students have been working on measuring to the nearest quarter-inch. This week, we will be learning about frequency tables and line plots. Students will be collecting measurement data in order to create line plots. We will also start December math challenge stations.

Science: Conservation

The final earth science unit, conservation, has started this past week as students learned about how our resources are used and conserved. We will explore the 3 R's (reduce, reuse, recycle) and contamination. The final conservation assessment will be on December 12th.
