Mapping Out Our Week

Reading: Reading Workshop

In reading, we will be working on identifying the problem and solution in a fictional story. Students will determine the problem, steps that lead toward the resolution, and the final solution. We will be focusing on folktales this week. Students will also review visualization strategies.

Writing: Writing Workshop

In writing, we will write a comparison essay about two different texts. It will relate to our problem/solution study in reading workshop. Students will also be quickly reviewing sentences, capitalization, punctuation, and noun concepts in grammar and FUNdations (plurals).

Math: Unit 6 - Measurement/Time

Students will begin unit six by studying the measurement of time. Students will review telling time to the nearest minute on analog and digital clocks. We will also learn about AM/PM and begin to work on figuring out elapsed time. Many students still struggle with telling time.

Social Studies: Government

In social studies, we will be learning about what it means to be a good citizen and how people should contribute to their communities. We will also explore the rights and responsibilities of individual members of a community.
