Mapping Out Our Week

Reading: Reading Workshop

In reading, we will be working on cause and effect. Students will be exploring how each event in a story leads to another one. We will also be learning about the genre of historical fiction – literature that is fictional but takes place in a period of historical significance.

Writing: Writing Workshop

In writing, we will be continuing to write in order to respond to literature. Students will also be finishing up some published works as they prepare to submit their second quarter writings. We will finish reviewing plural noun rules and work on transition words (first, then, etc.)

Math: Unit 6 - Measurement/Time

Students will continue working with creating schedules and elapsed time this week. We will also begin to work on measuring and estimating the amount of liquid volume and mass. The students will be focusing on metric units of measurement (liters/milliliters and grams/kilograms).

Social Studies: Government

In social studies, we will complete our first part of the government unit dealing with being a good citizen. Students will also learn about problem solving. The assessment for this section will be given on Friday.
