### Mapping Out Our Week

### Reading: Reading Workshop

In reading, we will be enhancing our study of characterization. We will be focusing on character traits and trying to use stronger descriptive language. For example, instead of happy, we may say a character is enthusiastic or thrilled!

### Writing: Writing Workshop

This week, students will be writing to describe characters from their reading selections. We will begin to study pronouns and be introduced to adjectives. Students will also be exposed to shades of meaning in words (nibble to munch to devour) while describing characters.

### Math: Unit 6 - Measurement/Time

We will be starting measurement of volume and mass this week. These lessons will focus primarily on metric measurements. Students will learn what tools are used when measuring, as well as how to estimate volumes and masses. We will really emphasize choosing the best unit.

#### Science: Matter

In science, we will work on classification. Students will also learn how to define matter and identify examples. We will review the phases of matter. Students will participate in a couple of activities and experiences to help reinforce the concepts being learned this week.
