Mapping Out Our Week

Reading: Reading Workshop

In reading, we will be continuing to work on how characters change throughout a story. We will also look at what would happen if characters changed differently than written in the original text. At the end of the week, we will be starting to explore some expository texts.

Writing: Writing Workshop

This week, students will still be practicing adjectives as we describe our characters. They will be creating adjective bugs and work on shades of meaning. Students will also start learning about writing informational pieces as we talk about researching topics.

Math: Unit 6 - Measurement/Time

We will be completing our measurement/time unit this week. Students will be taking the final test on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>February 3rd</u>, which is when the study guide is due. The next unit, unit 7, will be focused on understanding the relationship between multiplication and division.

Science: Matter

In science, we will complete matter this week by reviewing volume and mass. We will be conducting a couple of experiments. We will also learn about how water demonstrates all three states of matter. The matter assessment will be given on Friday, February 6th.
