Mapping Out Our Week

Reading: Reading Workshop

We will venture into reading workshop this week as we continue to explore attitudes about reading. Students will also learn how to choose "just right" books on their own. As we wrap up our first book/movie unit, additional information about subsequent units will come home soon.

Writing: Writing Workshop

Writer's Notebooks are ready to go! We will set "New Year's Resolutions" for writing and begin to learn about seeds for writing. Seeds are ideas and experiences from which we can choose to create original writing pieces. We will also review writing complete sentences.

Math: Unit 1

Students will begin unit 1 – Equal Groups in Multiplication and Division. While memorization of multiplication and division facts is essential for higher levels of math, the true importance lies in understanding of the concepts. We will explore just what it means to multiply/divide.

Social Studies: Map Skills

We will continue to learn about parts of a map in social studies. This week, we are focusing on using a compass rose with cardinal directions (N, E, S, and W) and utilizing a map key with representational symbols.
