Mapping Out Our Week

Reading: Reading Workshop

In reading, we will be learning about characters and how their traits are determined by their needs/wants, feelings, and actions. Students will be focusing on using textual evidence to "prove" their ideas. We will also celebrate our reading lives on Friday – more information coming!

Writing: Writing Workshop

In writing, we will continue to review complete sentences, as well as proper capitalization and punctuation. Students will also be learning how to take their "seeds" and begin to turn them into stories. We will be writing personal narratives about a person that matters to us.

Math: Unit 2 – Area/Arrays

Unit 2 begins with helping students understand the concept of area and why it is important in real life. We will also focus on tiling in order to help us find the area of both regular and irregular figures. Students will work on choosing which units of measurement are most effective.

Science: Soil and Rocks

We are continuing to analyze our soil samples from home. We will also create a model of soil and explore the four components of soil. Students will determine whether or not their soil/models are good for growing.
