### Mapping Out Our Week

#### Reading: Reading Workshop

In reading, we will be working with sequencing and comparing/contrasting. Students will be looking at the genre of biography, as we look at the events happening in a famous person's life. Our Book & Movie Club has kicked off as The Wizard of Oz is this month's selection.
