Mapping Out Our Week

Reading: Reading Workshop

In reading, we are working on finding details to support main ideas. This week, we will be focusing on expository (non-fiction) text as students read informational selections. A reminder that the <u>Wizard of Oz</u> ticket is due by next <u>Monday</u>, <u>October 27</u> for those participating.

Writing: Writing Workshop

In writing, students are working hard to complete a published fictional narrative. They are combining all of their writing strategies into one final piece. Rough drafts have been written, so students will be editing, revising, and publishing this week. Best of luck to our authors!

Math: Unit 3 - Subtraction/Rounding

We will practice subtraction using concrete models leading to the traditional method. We will also practice applying subtraction to real world situations. Students are working on carefully checking over their work and practicing facts to avoid careless errors while subtracting.

We will finish learning about how humans modify or change their environment. We will also explore how communication moves ideas from place to place. The final quiz will be given on Wednesday, October 22nd.
