BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District, by and through responsible administrators, reviewed the time and distance required to provide the transportation, the number of pupils to be transported, the cost of equipment, maintenance personnel, and administration essential for the transportation, similarity or equivalence of

services provided to other pupils eligible for transportation, whether and to what extent the additional service unavoidably disrupts transportation schedules and whether other reimbursable types of transportation are available regarding these schools.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Rocky River City School District that it declares it is impractical to provide transportation to these schools due to the time and distance required to provide the transportation, the number of pupils to be transported, the cost of equipment, maintenance, personnel, and administration essential for the transportation, similarity or equivalence of services provided to other pupils eligible for transportation, the additional service unavoidably disrupts current transportation schedules, and/or the availability of other reimbursement types of transportation and hereby agrees to provide compensation to parents in lieu providing such transportation;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby awards a contract for construction to Roma Designs, LLC in the amount of \$192,000 for the Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby accepts a donation and contribution from the Rocky River Campus Foundation, LLC in the amount of \$76,800 for this Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon receipt of the donation and contribution from the Rocky River Campus Foundation, LLC in the amount of \$76,800 for this Project, the Superintendent and Treasurer are hereby authorized to sign all necessary documents and to take all other actions necessary to carry this resolution into effect.
