Halloween unit! Fundations

This week we will learn how to add suffixes to words with a silent e. When a consonant suffix is added, it is simply added to the end of a word. If a vowel suffix is added to a vowel consonant e word, the e is dropped and the suffix is added. In addition, we will revisit adding suffixes to 1-1-1 words. Please work with your child at home by using the Fundations homework packets. These concepts are tricky and the students need many opportunities to master these skills!




