In order to support every students learning, we will follow a behavior system in our classroom. This system will give students responsibility for the choices they make each day, keep parents informed about their child's behavior, and provide the entire class with maximal opportunity to grow as learners.

Our Behavior System consists of three parts		
<u>Student Star Sheet:</u> Every Friday your child will bring home the student star sheet. This sheet will help you have a good understanding of your child's behavior for the week. Please initial the sheet each week. Your child is responsible for returning this sheet on Monday's.	<u>Yellow/Red Cards:</u> Each child has a small pocket attached to their desk. If a child needs to be reminded of the rules they will receive a yellow card (warning). If they continue to need reminded they will receive a red card and take a note home to their parents informing them of the negative behavior(s). (See back)	<u>Ribbons:</u> When a student displays a positive and/or supporting behavior they can receive a ribbon from the teacher. Students will keep their ribbons in a plastic bag in their desk. Students can trade in collected ribbons for prizes.

{Am I making good choices and respecting others, myself and things?}

Choose... Make a good choice.

Act... Make the situation better.
