Meeting called to order by M. Meyer at 9:05 am

2nd VP Report: (H. Horton & R. Winton):

- off to a great start
- enrollment up to 845
- open house tonight 7pm
- front entrance new wrap (style and security - can see out, but can't see in)
- Bickford Senior Center - donation of school supplies for students in need throughout District
- Ohio graduation requirements - changes on the State level
 - House Education Committee has shelved all alternative pathways for this year's seniors and beyond
 - Course work + testing
- State report cards being released today
 - achievement (performance index score - how schools are ranked across the state - how well they score on State tests - highest 120) come into play with teacher evaluations, as well - some schools have AP kids take State test to bolster their State scores
 - indicators in certain subjects (usually 80%) HS B (geometry missed by 1% point - retest kids also calculated in - now will only score retest scores - last year score counted twice)
 - gifted indicator - none met - how many students are identified as gifted AND receiving services (at HS either advanced, honors, AP and CC+) and teachers now have to go through 15 hours of prof development per year - if teachers not qualified, whole class is called NOT serving gifted... HS 79%, WEPs not filed with state, they are not being served
 - attendance indicator - new - all schools met
 - progress/value added (4-8grade - all subjects) HS English and Math - students making one-year's worth of progress - basically freshmen/sophomores
 - gap closing - similar to progress - kids in subgroups are closing the gaps (income-based, race, ethnicity, disability)
 - graduation - 4 and 5 year rate
 - prepared for success - how many had remediation free ACT/SAT test, got honors diplomas, bonus points: AP score of 3 or higher, CC+ got 3 credits in HS career (State says non-academic, but it is)
 - next year ELL improvement and now a financial data piece on report card
