On May 4, the Rocky River City Schools will have a 4.9 mill property tax levy (Issue 11) on the ballot. At this time, a 1.0 mill levy will be expiring, making the actual cost to homeowners 3.9 mill. The passage of this levy will ensure the continuance of critical school operations necessary to keep our academics strong, our schools safe and our students healthy, both mentally and physically. 

Are you looking for a great job? The American Red Cross lifeguard program is the place to begin! Through classroom activities, group discussion, and hands-on practice, you'll learn the skills you need to be a lifeguard.

Our comprehensive Lifeguard Training course includes topics covering accident prevention, lifeguarding techniques, emergency systems, and rescue skills. The course includes certifications in CPR for the Professional Rescuer (with AED), and First Aid. You must be 15 years of age and pass the prerequisite swim test on the first night of the class.

The Aquatics Department will be hiring lifeguards for Spring Employment.

American Red Cross CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers

Date: 03/27/2021

Time: 9:00am - 1:00pm

Location: Memorial Hall

The American Red Cross CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers course is specifically designed to teach those with a duty to act (professional rescuers and health care providers) the knowledge and skills needed to respond appropriately to beathing and cardiac emergencies until more advanced medical personnel take over. This includes the use of an automated external defrillator (AED) to care for a victim experiencing cardiac arrest.

To successufully complete the course, you must attend the entire course, participate and demonstrate competency in all required skills and scenarios, and pass the final written exam with a minimum grade of 80 percent.
