### **RRHS Named 2020 National Blue Ribbon School**

RRHS was one of just 367 schools nationwide to earn the prestigious National Blue Ribbon School award that were announced on September 24. RRHS was recognized as an Exemplary High Performing School as one of the state's highest performing schools measured by state assessments or nationally normed tests. RRHS is one of just 16 schools in the state of Ohio — and the only high school - to earn the National Blue Ribbon award this year. RRHS has now earned the National Blue Ribbon School distinction three times (1997-98, 2012 & 2020).
