## A Note From Mrs. Fiorillo

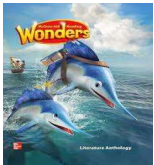


We are excited it is Home-Coming week in Rocky River!

## A Peek At What We Are Learning



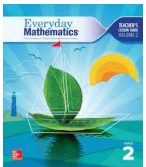
### Reading
