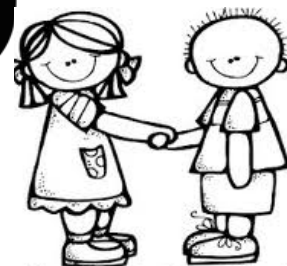


Room 208's Weekly Newsletter

math workshop	This week the students will be exploring a variety of ways to add 2 and 3 digit numbers together. We will also be learning the Associative Property of Addition which allows a mathematician to regroup numbers.
Reading workshop	The readers in room 208 will focus on using their visualizing and characterization to help us comprehend texts more easily. We will also begin rotating through out Daily 5 stations this week!
writing workshop	We will continue focusing on developing strong leads to our writing this week. Later in the week, we will experiment with using sensory words to "show" our reader what is happening in our story rather than just "telling" them.
science® S.S.	We will continue working through the scientific process this week by experimenting with paper airplanes! As scientists, we will discover the importance of being detailed in our lab reports so that another scientist can complete our experiment in the exact same way.

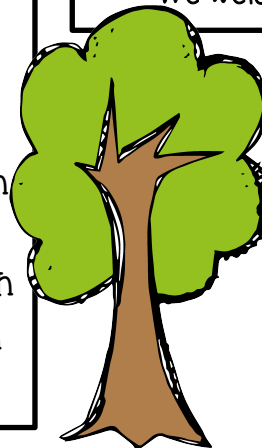
