## Week at a glance

<b>math workshop</b>	This week the students will be exploring a variety of ways to subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers together. We will also continue using estimation to help us predict our answers.
<b>Reading workshop</b>	The readers in room 208 will focus on using their visualizing and story mapping to help us comprehend texts more easily. This week we will introduce the "Work on Writing" station as a part of the Daily 5!
<b>writing workshop</b>	As we consciously write strong lead in sentences, the students will start working with strong details to help their readers' visualize what they are trying to say. We will be looking at sensory words and edit sentences so that they paint a picture in the mind when read.
<b>science S.S.</b>	This week we will look at how scientists use tools to help them better perform experiments. We will also use some of the tools this week to perform experiments of our own.
<b>Foundations</b>	<p>This week we will look closely at 1-1-1 words. This concept is ESSENTIAL for students to understand as we begin adding suffixes and changing base words. Please support your child at home as they complete the nightly homework.</p> <p>What is a 1-1-1 word?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-1 syllable</li> <li>-1 vowel</li> <li>-1 consonant at the end</li> </ul> <p>Ask your child to sing you the song! The tune goes to the "Five Dollar Footlong" jingle!</p> <p>Examples: rip, stop, grab, and grin</p> <p><b>Sound Alike Words:</b> banned and band</p> <p><b>Cursive Letters:</b> i, j, p, r, s, t</p>
