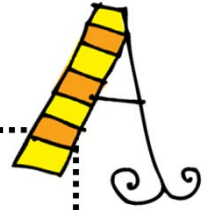

Dear Parents,

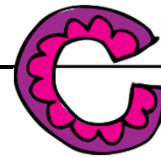

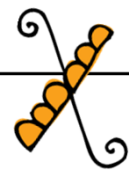

Unit 1 Week 1 Vocabulary Words



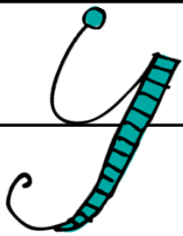
ache	To hurt or feel sore
