## **Preschool Peer Model Screening**

Rocky River Preschool will be holding a Peer Model Screening on July 8, 2014 at 12:00 PM for enrollment in the fall 2014-2015 school year. Peer models selected to participate within the special education preschool program should be at least 3 years old by the start of the 2014-2015 school year and must be a resident of Rocky River.

Peer models must be developing typically in all early childhood domains. The domains include physical motor development, social development, language and communication, vision and hearing, pre-academic, and cognitive skills development. The July 8<sup>th</sup> play-based session will last approximately a half hour and will include a playtime for your children where we will assess their skills in the previously mentioned areas.

Children learn best from each other and peer models help facilitate appropriate actions and behaviors for students with disabilities. Peer relationships are important for the social and cognitive development of all children.
