

# TALENT SHOW GUIDELINES

Please read the following information carefully for guidelines and required dates of attendance prior to registering your child.

## ELIGIBILITY:

- MC (Master of Ceremonies) and STAGE CREW are ONLY open to 5<sup>th</sup> graders.
- Students may perform individually or as a group act.
- Parents must register acts by Friday, December 1st, 2023.

## PLANNING YOUR ACT:

- Please keep all acts G Rated! Lyrics, costumes and performances should be appropriate for all ages.
- Music and performances will be screened at auditions.
- All acts are limited to a maximum of 2 minutes.
- All props need to be provided by the student(s).
- If your act requires a recorded accompanying music, it must be provided **BEFORE** the audition.

## AUDITIONS AND REHEARSALS:

- Auditions will be held in the KIS Commons starting at 3:00pm Monday, December 4th and Tuesday, December 5th.
- Dress Rehearsals and Talent Show Performances will be held at the RRHS Auditorium.
- Students will be divided into 2 separate evening performances. One show will be on Thursday, February 1st and the other show will be Friday, February 2nd. We do this to provide a variety in the show and to make sure the time frame of the show stays within 2 hours.
- Students must be at the dress rehearsal in order to participate in the talent show.
- Thursday Show performers will have dress rehearsal on Monday, January 29th.
- Friday Show performers will have dress rehearsal on Tuesday, January 30th.
- Stage Crew will attend the designated nights rehearsal and performance dates.
- Students only need to attend their own designated audition time, dress rehearsal, and performance.

## MUSIC GUIDELINES:

- If your act requires recorded accompanying music, please submit the following NAME OF THE SONG, ARTIST, AND SPECIAL VERSION (if applicable)
